Begin Dog Training Using These Recommendations

Specifically, the dog should not pull you. They should walk next to you. To prevent your dog from pulling you along, using a Martingale collar, which has an extra loop, will tighten should they pull away at any time. The key to teaching your dog to walk on a leash is for you to set the pace. If the dog begins to pull you, stop walking. Never began walking until there is slack in the leash line. The heel is not the same. This has to do with your dog at your side. All you want to focus upon is teaching your dog not to pull you on the leash. The stay command is very important, and it's one of the most difficult things to teach your dog. Every dog likes to follow humans, specifically their masters. You shouldn't try to teach him this command until he already knows how to sit. When the dog is sitting, you can begin to teach him to stay as you walk away from him. The dog, if it stays in one spot, should be rewarded with a treat. If he doesn't remain seated, don't punish him but ignore him and then start the process over again. It may take a few sessions before he starts to understand what stay means.

Most modern experts will agree that the archaic use of a rolled up newspaper and hitting your dog on the nose for training is a thing of the past. You don't want your dog to be afraid of you. Angry words yelled at your dog should never be used. This can only be detrimental to the discipline and training of your canine. To get the best response out of your dog, the best dog trainers will agree that they need to be in control of their emotions. Training your dog using fear tactics is absolutely not acceptable, and it will lead to aggression on the part of the dog later. The best way to do training is using your words in a positive way and disciplining through confinement and rebukes.
