Comparison Of Brit Blue And Russian Blues

Picking a cat to become part of your home are a private choice, and one you want to try with the finest data available. A British short hair cat can easily be mistaken for a Russian blue. The blue or silver-gray version of the [British shorthair](#) is analogous in color markings to a Russian blue. Both have short, thick bluish fur. Nevertheless a British short hair kitten has more muscle and thick body than a Russian blue kitten. While Russian blues typically have a lengthened and elegant body, British short hairs are far more squat in shape. The British shorthair's tail is thicker than the Russian blue's; both taper from the body, but the British shorthair's tail is more blunt.

The face of a British short hair is generally more round than that of a Russian blue. Some British short hairs have the appearance of having round cheeks. Russian blues, on the other hand, customarily have a more triangular face. Russian blues often have bright green eyes, while British short hairs that are blue often have brown eyes. From a cultured point of view, both breeds are widely thought of as entrancing. The solemnness of their differences comes down to your private preference.

Though all true Russian blues have a blue-gray coat, that isn't so of British short hairs. The British short hair can be silver-blue, gray, cream, cinnamon, or a mixture of these colors. It's not peculiar for British short hairs to have a tortoise-shell pattern. Nonetheless only the silver-blue British short hair is most likely going to be mistaken for a Russian blue.

Their short hair isn't given to often tangling or becoming knotted, and moderate brushing and a sensible diet is all that is critical to keep the coat looking graceful and healthy. Both the Russian blue and the British short hair have a peaceful disposition. However , Russian blues are apt to be vocal, while British short hairs sometimes aren't.
