Use your time walking the dog as time for bonding and positive reinforcement. Try bringing your treats along and playing games with them during the walk. Ask him to sit in the middle of your walk and reward him with a snack. Reinforce the love he has for your dog and that he will respond in kind.

House training your puppy can be a lot faster and more effective using a crate. The crate should never be used for punishment. The puppy should be put in the crate at night and in between times of interaction with his owner. His natural instinct is to not relieve himself in his sleeping area.

Establish a standing rule that entering a room means ignoring the dog. Whether it is you, your family or guests, keep the pattern consistent. Do not allow your dog to establish the tone for the room from excitement or mischievous behavior. Anytime he enters the room whether the animal is his or not, he should take command of the room and then interact with the dog if he is calm.

You need to recognize when your dog is behaving in a way that you do not want to do. Do not reinforce any desirable behavior that you do not want to see. Do not reinforce the behavior that you intend for them to behave. By reinforcing what is right, it will help the dog develop good habits and start acting that way regularly.

When training your dog to deal with fear or anxiety related behaviors, go slow. Responding to fear or anxiety response with aggression only leads to more fear and even more mistrust. Take your time and give your dog the opportunity to succeed. He will grow in confidence and reduce fear induced behaviors.

One of the first things a dog should learn is to know his name. This is called his name. To start getting him used to his name, use it positively every time he joins the family. Every time he does something you praise him for, he will find that his name is a positive experience.

The diet you are feeding your dog needs to match their needs and activity level. The diet that is right for a working dog is a lot different from that of a dog that lounges around the house all day. Talk with your vet regarding what is right for your pup and don't forget that their needs will change as they age.
