Dogs learn well through a reward system that incorporates repetitive techniques. You need to demonstrate proper behavior, then work with your dog over time and reward him when he does the right thing. That's how dogs learn to grasp tricks. You should show them through repeated practice accompanied with rewards.

Your dog needs to lead an active lifestyle. Dogs become bored very easily. A bored dog is very difficult to train. When your dog is happy and well-exercised, he will be more willing to pay attention to his training. Before every training session, prepare your dog by taking him for a walk.

Stay consistent when you're trying to train your dog. Write down the commands that you use and then make sure that the same person who needs to know them does. Behavior should be rewarded or not depending on the affect that is being sought. Be having different responses from different people will make it confuse the dog, which makes the training more problematic.

Learn to incorporate positive reinforcement when training, in place of treat based rewards. Giving treats to dogs in order to teach them new behavior is quite effective. You should not constantly have to treat in your pant's pockets. Hugging or patting your dog is a good way to replace treats.

If you want your dog to follow the rules, keep training it, it needs to be refreshed! On the other hand, most common mistakes pet owners make are assuming that once training has been completed, no maintenance is required thereafter. However, pets and humans share similar habit systems. That's why on-going training is important.

When training your dog against improper chewing, be sure to set them up for success. In addition, keep the household objects that would be dangerous away from your pet. Keep items that your dog might choke on put away, including nylons, hairbrushes, and common items that are typically left around the house.

Be sure to stay consistent with the commands you choose to train your dog with. Your dog will learn to associate a command with the resulting behavior, but if you keep changing the command associated with the behavior, you'll confuse him and he won't do what you want him to do. It's very important to be consistent. By enforcing this, your training sessions will be very effective.

You don't want to use wee-wee pads when potty training your dog. The pads eventually leak; leaked waste marks certain areas in the house as "potty areas". That's why you should convince your dog that something similar in appearance is an acceptable surface to use for bathroom purposes. That's the best option to toilet train your dog outdoors.

Training a dog requires the use of constantly repeated words or actions for the specific required behavior. A dog will respond to that positively, and then will start to associate that action or word with the kind of behavior. It's important to be consistent. By doing this, you will have a higher rate of success with training your pet.

You need to make sure that your dog is having fun during day-long training sessions. By playing games with your dog, a strong bond will develop between the two of you, which helps the dog respond in a positive manner during training. Training should be fun experience, however, getting some enjoyment for yourself and the dog through play is a good thing.

Always get your dog's attention before using his name. That's why direct his attention to you immediately every time, and repeat the right behavior if you issue a command. Get your dog's attention three to ten times every day. Make sure you never punish your pet for responding to his name.

If you're house training a dog, try using a crate. Let your dog roam free all day, though, or crate training could have adverse effects. On a properly trained dog that hasn't been crate trained, it's likely to have an accident.

If you want to train your dog, avoid playing any sort of control games like tug of war. These, along with chasing and wrestling, can encourage them to bite your hands. These bad behaviors will be hard to get rid of and are counter intuitive to your training efforts. To save them from further than dog has learned clear, well established guidelines on how to act.

Dog training isn't how you set rules for your dog, so that it understands the relationship. On these rules are in place and followed consistently, your dog will have an easier time understanding its role and your needs. Don't forget to remind your dog of what it has learned. Always keep a close eye but don't hesitate to enforce proper punishment on any violations of the designated rules.
